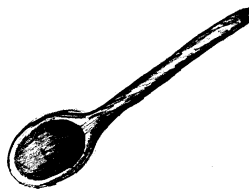

After the search, carefully put aside any leaven found for burning on the next day. The following is said to nullify any unknown leaven:

Nullification Statement

May any leaven or leavened product that is still in my possession, which I have not seen nor removed, and of which I am unaware, become nullified and ownerless as the dust of the earth.
